The Centre Management Board (CMB)

I. Purpose

The main responsibility of the Centre Management Board (CMB) is to oversee the strategic development and financial planning of SHE.

II. Composition

The members of the CMB are appointed for a period of **5 years** (students **1 year**) and include:

The Director of SHE acts as secretary to the CMB.

III. Process and Operations

1. Meetings

The CMB meets at least four times per year based on a pre-approved calendar.

2. Quorum

A quorum at any meeting shall be a simple majority of the members of the CMB.

IV. Duties and Responsibilities

I. Approves, at least annually, the strategic plan and the objectives of SHE and oversees their execution. This oversight includes reviewing and approving all major strategy and policy recommendations and monitoring SHE's performance against the strategic plan using appropriate metrics and milestones.

- II. Reviews the opportunities and risks of SHE's annual plan and, if deemed advisable, approves such plan, including the budget for the following year.
- III. Reviews quarterly reports from the executive director and discusses results according to objectives.
- IV. Reviews and approves budgets and annual financial reports.
- V. Oversees SHE's general approach to human resources and plans for employees.

V. Board Mandate Review

On an annual basis, the CMB reviews this mandate and approves such changes as are necessary.
